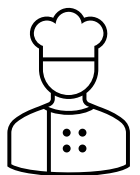
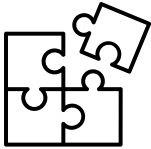
On the fifth day, students engaged in construction challenges like building the Longest Great Wall of China out of Lego and racing in a Lego Maze.

I am excited to start my journey with OSHClub where I can showcase my creative energy to help kids grow and foster independence... and of course have fun!



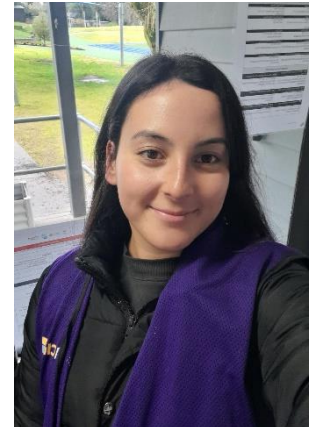
